Life Group Study Notes

Study based on Isaiah 40:1-31 – Nov 19, 2017

Something happens when we sense the waiting is coming to an end. Regardless of the difficulty or the outcome, every season of waiting has a lesson.

In this closing message we look a passage written to speak into one of the darkest periods for the nation of Israel. The message for them still holds true today and transforms any season of waiting into hopeful anticipation.
